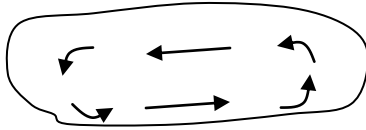


# THE LAKESIDE OUTING CLUB, INC.

## To be posted in Cottage

### SAFETY & WATER

1. Motor boating for skiing and pleasure riding will be from 10 A.M. to 8 P.M. (or dusk) whichever is earlier.
2. Operation of motor boats outside of above hours is to be done at idling speed (5 mph or less) NO WAKE.
3. All motorboats must be operated in a **counterclockwise** direction:



4. Standing, sitting on seat backs, gunwales or decks while motorboat is operating is NOT permitted.
5. All watercraft require a sound-producing device on board.
6. Watercrafts without L.O.C. decals are not permitted on the lake.
7. All watercraft must have proper lights 1/2 hour before sunset. Lights should be visible from 100' in all directions.
8. DO NOT SWIM OR FLOAT more than 50' from the shoreline during boating hours.
9. NO jet skis, hydroplanes or high performance watercraft are permitted on the Lake.
10. MOTORBOATS SHOULD GIVE RIGHT OF WAY TO NON-MOTORIZED WATERCRAFT and wide berth to fishermen, water skiers, etc.
11. No person under 14 years of age shall operate a power craft without a boat/licensed adult or other operator qualified by successful completion of any approved watercraft safety course.
12. Persons born on or after January 1, 1982, may not operate a boat with greater than 25hp unless they have obtained and have in possession a Boating Safety Education Certificate.
13. No more than one tow rope and one device being towed per boat.

### GENERAL RULES/ REGULATIONS COURTESY (SUMMARY - NOT ALL.)

1. All dues should be paid by JUNE 15. Failure to do so results in an initial surcharge of \$15.00 and additional surcharges for continued failure to be in good standing. If dues are not paid on time you will not be able to vote at the annual meeting.
2. Each share in good standing shall be permitted to use no more than (4) watercraft. No more than ONE POWERED BY A MOTOR EXCEEDING 15 HP with a MAX. OF 60 HP.

3. All watercraft must be owned by the shareholder. All watercraft must display L.O.C. decal on both sides of the craft. (Motorboats, canoes, sailboats, rowboats, paddleboats. etc..)
4. Renters of L.O.C. property and/or shareholder's cottages are NOT allowed to use any motorboats over 15 HP. Renters are not allowed to use any of their own watercraft.
5. All guests using L.O.C. property (clubhouse, beach, walking trails, and all common land) MUST BE accompanied by the L.O.C. shareholder or have the express permission of the shareholder.
6. Written permission must be obtained from the Board of Directors for the installation of all docks, piers, rafts, jetties and floats to be built on or in the lake, which is club property. Permission is also required when any modification to the shoreline such as bulkheads or seawalls is to be made. NOTE: Lakeside Outing Club, Inc. owns bottom and water of Page Lake along with other communal land property.
7. No chemical or other substance shall be introduced into the Lake for weed or other controls or purposes by anyone not duly authorized by the Board of Directors to do so.
8. Sale or other transfer of property DOES NOT convey club privileges, water rights or stock rights to new owner. SEE BY-LAWS.
9. All shareholders/property owners must keep septic and holding tanks in good working order. NO SEPTIC RUN-OFF ALLOWED.
10. Responsibility of shareholders of each cottage/property to inform guests and renters of all rules and regulations.

### COURTESY:

1. After 10:00 PM noise level kept to a minimum.
2. Security lights/floodlights should not shine out onto the lake.
3. Do not let dogs run, etc., on your neighbor's property.
4. Do not leave your dogs home barking.

### WEED CONTROL:

DO NOT use products containing phosphorus (fertilizers, cleaning products.. etc.,)

### BE SMART

For your own good do not use anti-bacterial products if you have a septic system. Septic systems need bacteria to work.
